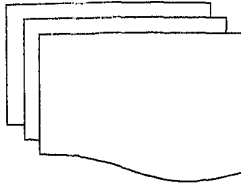

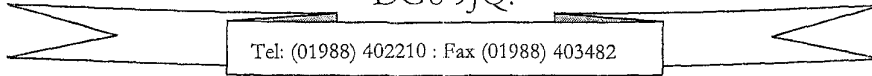
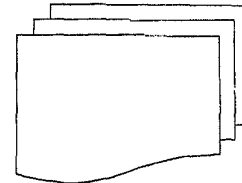

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

This is to certify that William Boyd, DOB 19.06.65 has been seen by me yesterday regarding the distress caused to him by the separation from his daughter, Aela. He is unable to take on a job because the only opportunity when he is allowed to visit his daughter is during the working week rather than at weekends. He is not suffering from any mental illness but is anxious about his daughter's health and safety in the care of her mother and her mother's family.

I believe that more generous access for Mr Boyd to his daughter at weekends would go some way to relieving his stress although in the longer term a reuniting of himself with his daughter would be beneficial to him.

I would be grateful if any measures could be taken to improve the situation for Mr Boyd. He is on no medication and is on good health.

I have also read the psychologist's report written by Dr Valerie Cairns regarding the situation of Mr Boyd and his daughter and feel that this report and the findings should be taken into consideration in illuminating the effect of the separation between father and daughter and its effect on them both.
